Interclub meets. Southside races against one or two other clubs. This is great experience for our younger swimmers 12 years and under. May be at Wesley pool or another clubs home pool.

Club days. Run at Wesley pool as a formal meet. You need to enter through the club website by Thursday night before that Saturday. Best level of competition for our newer members. (When we have an official referee and stroke judges we can use times as official SWA times.)

Junior club. Run at Wesley pool and only for our younger members. Senior team members may be training or at other competition. Great for no pressure racing for our younger members 12/under. Also an opportunity for new parents to help run the meet under no pressure.
